

Kuzma

Turntables have been around a long time, so you might be forgiven for thinking all the innovation in LP replay was behind us. Franc Kuzma would politely disagree, then show you his drawing board (and it is a drawing board... no CAD for Franc!). Kuzma has been pushing the limits of what a turntable and a tonearm can do for decades.

Unlike many turntable makers, Kuzma is not tied to any one technology. There have been suspended platters, air bearing platters, AC and DC motors, unipivots, gimbaled

and parallel tracking air-bearing arms. While most of Franc Kuzma's models are high-mass platter designs, even this is not set in stone at Kuzma. The right tools for the job are used, largely depending on the size of the system. And Kuzma is a maker who builds a turntable expected to both be built for decades and last for decades. With Kuzma, it's all about vinyl's long game.
